



The Den

In November 2003 a group of young people from Café K completed a three-month project aimed towards restoring an unused art room in the Jack Kane Centre to a dedicated youth facility for the wider community. The young people actively participated in all aspects of this project from the involvement of Standard Life who worked with the young people as part of a team building community challenge, identifying and applying for funding sources and the design and contents of the room to name a few. To date the Den (dedicated youth facility) is now up and running and is accessed by a variety of young people and various other groups such as adult learning from Greater Craigmillar. This dedicated youth workroom has therefore impacted upon reducing territorialism amongst young people from across the area particularly in relation to the location of the Jack Kane Centre. This room is regularly used due to its relaxed decoration.
